

FAQ for Registration and nomination for Prime Minister's Awards, 2020

1.	Query	Can one applicant fill up nominations in different categories?
	Reply	Yes.
2.	Query	Whether Municipality/ Local authority needs to send their nomination through DC/DM in DPIP viz Promoting Jan Bhagadari or in Innovation categories?
	Reply	Yes.
3.	Query	Whether different ID will be required for different nominations?
	Reply	No, through a single ID nominations can be filled up in different categories.
4.	Query	The period of consideration is from 01.04.2018 to 31.03.2020. Can an Innovation for a shorter duration (within the prescribed timelines) may be considered. For example an innovation which started from 01.05.2018 and ended in 31.10.2018. Whether it can be considered?
	Reply	The period of consideration for all categories including Innovation is from 01.04.2018 to 31.03.2020. However an Innovation, which was implemented for a shorter period, within this time frame will be considered. For example, an Innovation started after 01.04.2018 and ended prior to 31.03.2020 will also be considered for this award.
5.	Query	Can a District/Organisation who could not able to register by 31.07.2020 submit their applications?
	Reply	The last date of registration has been extended till 15.08.2020. The district/organisation who have not registered by 31.07.2020 may registered and submit their application by 15.08.2020.
6	Query	For ADP category, NITI Aayog prepares Delta ranking for the Aspirational District. Whether District needs to apply for this category or the awards may be given on the Delta ranking
	Reply	Yes, the Aspirational District needs to apply on PM's Awards Portal as per the application format and the performance will be evaluated based on the data and prescribed parameter of Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration, 2020.
